ADMISSION POLICY

1. General Requirements

- 1.1. Pass the IGPS admission test
- 1.2. Submit the following:
 - 1.2.1. Accomplished IGPS Registration Form
 - 1.2.2. Transcript of Records
 - 1.2.3. Honorable Dismissal
 - 1.2.4. Certificate of Employment
 - 1.2.5. One (1) Passport size picture

2. Academic Requirements

2.1. For Master's Degree Program

- Must be a graduate of a related Bachelor's Degree.
- Applicants whose bachelor's degree is not directly related to the chosen master's degree program is required to take 12 units of bridging courses to meet the program requirements.

2.2. For MSCJ Program

- Must be a graduate of Bachelor of Science in Criminology (BSCrim)
- A passer of Criminology Board Examination or employed for at least 3 years with exemplary exposure or work experience in any of the branches of Criminal Justice sector; a certificate of Employment shall be required.

2.3. For Doctoral Degree Program

- Applicant must be a graduate of a master's degree with thesis in related field of specialization.
